### **Colorful Matthews: A Coloring Book**

Barbara Taylor, former Director of Matthews Heritage Museum and Barbara Stegall, Matthews Heritage Museum docent, former teacher, and pre-school director have created a delightful coloring book exploring the historic buildings of Matthews.

COLORFUL MATTHEWS features 15 pages of original pen and ink drawings of historic structures that can be colored. The artists are local history enthusiasts, Janet Dyer and Phil Tappy. These pictures are followed by information about each structure. Each page is perforated, and the 8 ½ x 11 format makes it easy to frame.

Among the featured structures are Matthews Heritage Museum, Renfrow's Hardware Store, Matthews Historic Cemetery, and Outen's pottery Kiln. Some of these landmarks are not well known by the local population, but this coloring book gives children, parents, and grandparents an opportunity to learn about the Matthews community, while they enjoy coloring each historic site. Each building's address is listed, as well as the history and year it was built, and the name of the current business, if appropriate. These books are now on sale for \$10 per copy.

**January 11<sup>th</sup>-27<sup>th</sup>, 2025** *American Revolution Experience National Exhibition.* Historic Robert Mills Courthouse, Lancaster, SC. Free. In-person. The *American Revolution Experience* is a compelling exhibit including three interactive kiosks and twelve informative panels, offering visitors an in-depth look into the lives of key Revolutionary War figures, the events that shaped the era, and the historical locations connected to these stories. Exhibit hours vary. Speakers, a Revolutionary War sites tour and a genealogy workshop are planned during the exhibit's time in Lancaster. **January 11th, 2025** 10:00 AM-12:00 PM *American Revolution Experience Opening Day*. In the Lancaster County Historic Robert Mills Courthouse on Main Street in Lancaster at 10 am, there will be a program on Eliza Lucas Pinckney's dresses and a Colonial Reception. Eliza Lucas Pinckney revolutionized agriculture in South Carolina as a teenager in the 1700's, perfecting indigo as a major cash crop in the state. At 1 pm is Liberty Live Education's interactive demonstration about the effects of smallpox on the people of that time and the soldiers in the field. This event is designed for middle and high school students and requires a ticket for entry. It also covers STEM school requirements. Tickets are available at [HERE](#).
